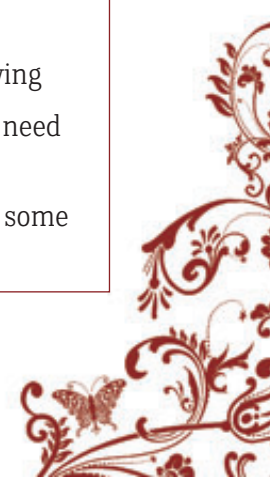

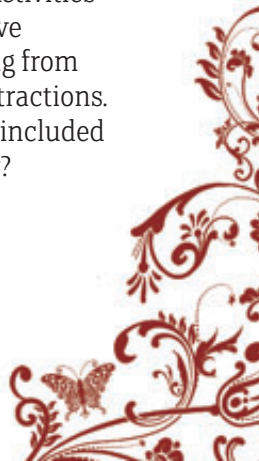

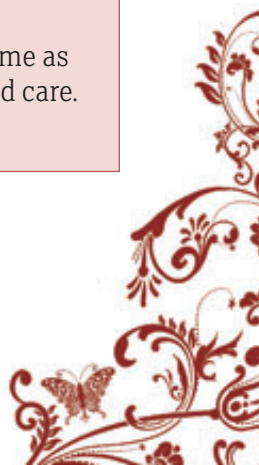
Specialist dementia and Alzheimer's wing

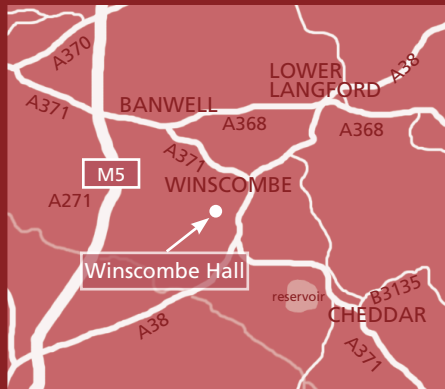
